 note is ninety one dollar and eighty one cent which ad
 the whole makes due to the said James Pickett by the said
 Kezanna Pickett is two hundred and sixty two dollars and
 sixteen cents, this is to certify unto all people whom it may
 concern that I Kezanna Pickett doth hereby receive of
 James Pickett two hundred and sixty two dollars and sixteen
 cents in full payment for a negro boy by the name of Willis
 which negro boy Willis I doth hereby warrant and forever defe
 -nd unto the said James Pickett against the lawful
 claim of my self or any other person or persons whatsoever
 as Witness here unto I doth I doth set my hand and seal this
 29th of November 1823.
