E 34 ch 40 Lk to a Stake & an James Batey line thence N. 15. W. 34 ch 40 Lk to a pine x thence N. 74. E. 10 ch to pole x thence N. to E 10 ch 40 Lk to a pine x thence S. 80 W 9 1/2 ch to a pole x thence S. 42 W. 2 1/2 ch to a pole x thence S. 47 E. 11 ch to a chern = ut. x of John Whittens thence S. 43 W a long S. John Whittens line to a pole x near a branch thence up the meanders of the Branch to the beginning supposed to contain one hundred and eighteen Acres be the same more or less it being part of a tract of land granted to Aaron Skout the 21 of September 1799 together with all and singular the Rights, menues, hereditaments and appurtenances belonging or in any wise incident to have and to hold all and singular the before mentioned premises unto him the said Alfred his heirs or assigns forever and I do hereby warrant and forever defend all and singular the before mentioned premises unto him the said Alfred against myself my heirs or any other person whomsoever claiming the same or any part thereof Witness my hand and seal the second day of March in the year 1825 and 49th year of American Independence
