 corners, thence along Labuce's own line S. 32 W.
 Forty poles and fourteen links to the Beginning cont-
 -aining two acres and one hundred and thirteen and a
 Half poles, Together with all and singular the rights,
 members, heriditaments, and appurtenances, to the
 same belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining
 To have and to hold to the said Joseph P. Labuce his
 heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself
 my heirs Executor, administrator, and assigns to war-
 -ant and forever defend all and singular the premises
 above mentioned to the said Joseph P. Labuce and his
 heirs against me and my heirs and against every
 other person or persons claiming or to claim the same
 or any part thereof. In witness where of I have hereun
 to set my hand and affixed my seal this second

Day of September A.D. 1825 and in the fiftieth year
 of the sovereignty and Independence of the united
 States of America. signed sealed and delivered in the
