of the State and district aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum
of three hundred and fifty dollars to me in hand paid by William
McNulty of the State and district aforesaid have bargained gran-
ted sold and released and by these presents do grant han-
-dled sell and release unto the said William McNulty a
plantation or tract of land situate in State and district
aforesaid on both sides of the South fork of Deer Creek
waters of Enoree River originally granted to William Steel and
from William Steel to John Steel and from John Steel to Benjamin
Kilgour and from said Kilgour to James Kilgour and from
James Kilgour to William Cannaday & from said
Cannaday to James Cannaday and from said Cannaday
to William Pickrell and from said Pickrell to Thomas Goldsmith
and from said Goldsmith back to William Pickrell and
from said Pickrell to Samuel Howard one hundred
and fifty acres be the same more or less of the above
butting and bounded as follows viz, beginning on
a post oak 3x thence N. 56 E. 30 to a post oak dead bounded
by Charles Bayant, thence S. 14 W. 33 to a stake 3x thence S. 50 W.
38.82 to a post oak 3x thence N. 30 E. 38 to a white oak 3x
thence N. 16 E. to the post oak to the beginning to include all
hundred and fifty acres be the same more or less
Together with all and singular the Rights, members
& Relictaments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging
or in any wise incident or pertaining to have and to
hold all and singular the premises as fore mentioned unto
the said McNulty his heirs and assigns against myself & my heirs Exe-
cutors, administrators and no further as it is to be understood that
the said Samuel Howard only conveys title and claim as to the of my
hand & seal this 25 of December 1823 in thousand eight hundred and twenty
three and in the forty seventh year of American independence
