assignes for ever and I do hereby bind my  
self my heirs Executors and administrators  
to warrant and for ever defend all and  
singular the fore said premises unto the said  
William Barton his heirs and assignes against  
myself my heirs and against every other  
Person or persons whomsoever lawfully  
claiming or to claim the same or any part  
there of as witness my hand and seal this twenty  
third day of October One thousand Eight  
Hundred and twenty four signed sealed and  
delivered in presence of us
