W. 6. 00. 40. to a chumut thence S. W. 9. 37. 00 to the beginning containing one hundred acres be the same more or less the said Land granted by a patent to Benjamin Barten on the sixth day of February A. D. 1816. Together with all & singular the Rights, liberties, Hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises beclaining or in any wise appertaining to have & to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Charles Sotherland his heirs and assigns and I do here bind myself my heirs & assigns to the said Sotherland his & assigns In witness I have hereunto set my hand & fix my seal this seventeenth of Nov: in the year A.
