 of the sum of three hundred and fifty two dollars to me paid by Tully & Sul-
 livan & Co of the State and district aforesaid have granted bargained sold
 and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto
 the said Tully & Sullivan & Co a parcel or tract of Land laying in the
 State and District aforesaid on the south side of the south fork of Roburns Creek
 and lying near the Laurens line beginning on a post oak 3+ on the old
 Indian boundary line thence North along said boundary line 24.50 to a
 red oak 3+ (at the road) thence N. 75° E. 36 to a black Gum on the bank
 of said Roburns Creek thence down the meanders of said Creek to the
 mouth of said James Kellott's Spring branch thence up the meanders of
 said Spring branch to a black Gum 3+ at the head of North or East fork
 of said Spring branch thence S. E. 17 to a stake 3+ on Derry Boyces line thence
 N. 45° W. 11 to a red oak 3+ thence west to the beginning post oak bounded
 on the south by Derry Boyces land on the west by John H. Parsons and on the
 north and east by said James Kellott's land it being part of the tract of land
 the said Kellott now lies on and including the place where the said Tully
 & Sullivan now lies with eighty eight acres of land be the same more
 or less together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments
 and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any wise incident or ap-
 pertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises above men-
 tioned unto the said Tully & Sullivan & Co their heirs and assigns forever
 and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators
 to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the premises before men-
 tioned unto the said Tully & Sullivan & Co from myself and my heirs
 and from every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to
 claim the same or any part thereof, witness my hand and seal this thirtieth
 Day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty
 one and in the forty fifth year of the Independance of the United States of
