



Micajah Berry his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors or administrators to warrant and forever defend all and sing-

 To have the use of it during my natural life & if I die before my  
 wife then she is to have the use of said Bed during her Life - In testa-  
 - menty where of I have here unto set my hand and affixed my seal  
 this Eighteenth day of July Eighteen hundred and twenty five
