Salmon & George Salmon of the District of Greenville in the State aforesaid are held and firmly bound jointly and severally unto James Pickett his heirs Executors Administrators and assigns in the full and just sum of Twenty thousand Dollars good and lawful money of the said State to be paid to the said James Pickett his certain Attorney his heirs Executors Administrators or assigns for which payment well and truly to be made and done we and each of us bind ourselves jointly and severally our joint and several heirs Executors Administrators and assigns for the whole and in the whole firm by these presents signed with our hands and sealed with our seals and dated this thirteenth day of February in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and twenty six The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above named William H. Salmon by his writing obligatory sealed with his seal and bearing evendate here with hath acknowledged himself to owe and obligated himself his heirs Executors Administrators and assigns to pay to the aforesaid James Pickett his heirs Executors Administrators or assigns the full and just sum of Ten thousand four hundred Dollars good and lawful money of the State of South Carolina to be paid in ten equal annual instalments and to pay the interest on the whole sum annually the first payment of one tenth part of the principal sum with the interest on the whole to be made on the thirteenth day of February Anno Domini 1827 and on that day in each and every successive year thereafter a payment of one tenth part of the principal sum with the interest on the whole amount which is and remains unpaid at the end of the preceding year is to be made until the whole is paid Now if the above named William H. Salmon his heirs Executors Administrators or assigns shall on the said thirteenth day of February A.D. 1827 pay or cause to be paid to the said James Pickett his heirs Executors Administrators or assigns on his certain attorney the lawful interest which shall accrue and become due on the said sum of Ten thousand four hundred
