E. 27 ch. to a Black oak thence N. 65. W. 5 ch. to a pine. Thence S. 22. W. to a stake 27 ch. on the bank of the river thence with the several meanders of the same to the Beginning being part of a survey made for Michael Miller patent bearing date January 21st 1785 for three hundred eighty eight acres by him conveyed to William Anderson by him to Wm Gaven and by him to me together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments & Appurtenances there unto belonging or in any wise pertaining to have & to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Anderson Butler and do here by bind my self my heirs Executors or administrators to warrant & for ever defend the above mentioned premises unto the said Anderson Butler his heirs & assigns against me & my heirs and against every person or persons laying any lawfull claim or demands thereunto or any part thereof In witness where of I have set my hand & seal this first day of June anni Domini 1810 and 34th year of Independence Signed seal & Delivered in presence of
