 do bargain & sell to said Cureton <sup>as by</sup> tract of land containing fifteen acres  
 more or less lying in the District aforesaid and on the mail road  
 Beginning at a red oak corner on the west side of sd road on sd Cureton  
 line thence up the road to a red oak corner on Ashmores line thence  
 westwardly to a corner black gum on the head of a branch thence down  
 said branch to said Cureton's line thence along said Cureton's line to the  
 Beginning which includes the land herein to be conveyed being  
 fifteen acres more or less together with all & singular the rights &  
 members and hereditaments unto the sd premises belonging or in  
 any wise incident or appertaining to have & to hold the sd premises  
 unto the sd Cureton his heirs & assigns for ever and I do hereby  
 Bind myself my heirs & c to warrant & for ever defend the sd  
 premises unto the said Cureton against myself & my heirs & against  
 all and every person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or
