

March 31 1807 South Carolina Know all men by these presents that I James Thaxton of Greenville District and State aforesaid for an consideration of the sum of fifty four dollars in hand paid by Samuel Crofford of the District and State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released And by these presents do grant bargain sell and sell unto the said Samuel Crofford a plantation or tract of land it being a part of a tract that was originally granted to Bath Birdsong and conveyed through different hands down to the said James Thaxton the land to be conveyed lying and being situate in the District and State aforesaid on the banks of Gilders Creek of Enoree is beginning on Stake Run N. 68. W. 41 to stake on Lesters line thence S 70 W. to stake then S 45 W. 23. 50 to pine 3+ then W 2. 57 to post 3+ then S 34. 22 to post oak 3+ then N 69. E. by dividing line between Wadsworth and him self to the beginning including two hundred acres together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances unto the said premises belonging or any wise incident or pertaining to have or to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Samuel Crofford and I hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Samuel Crofford his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof in controversy whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the condition of the above obligation is such that if the said James Thaxton do will and truly pay the said Samuel Crofford the just sum of fifty four Dollars with law full interest over before the fifteenth of December next ensuing the date hereof then this obligation is void And now effect other wise remain in full force and virtue, in presence of Rubens Taubksly John Crofford & James Thaxton

State of South Carolina Greenville District Know all men by these presents that Samuel Crofford of the District and State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars to me paid in hand by Paschal Rutledge of District and State aforesaid have this day Bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release a certain tract or parcel of Land containing two hundred acres unto the said Paschal Rutledge situate in District and State aforesaid and on the waters of Enoree River and bounded at dollars Beginning on a Stake and running N 68 W 41 to a Stake on Lesters line thence S 70 W to a Stake thence south 45 W 23. 50 to a pine 3+ thence thence W 2. 57 to a post oak 3+ thence south 34. 22 to a post oak 3+ thence North 69. E. by a dividing line Between Wadsworth and Thaxton to the beginning including two hundred acres of land
