95 State of South Carolina Know all men by these presents that I Nathaniel Harkin of Pendleton District the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars Lawfull money to me paid by William Redman of Greenville District and State of aforesaid I haith bargained sold and released & By these presents doth grant bargain sell & release unto the said William Redman a certain plantation or tract of land containing one hundred & fifty acres lying in Greenville District on a branch of brushy Creek of Enoke River which the sd William Redman now lies on and haith such boundaries as it beginning on a stone on Law. Hudsons N. E. line from thence to a post corner from thence S. E. to a large red oak corner from thence S. E. to a certain line beginning on a red oak from thence to the beginning it being a part of a tract of Land containing nine hundred & eighty three acres granted unto Law. Hudson from under the hand of his Excellency Charles Pinckney Esqr bearing date the thirty first day of June thousand thousand and ninety one Recorded in Book E No 5 page the 77 also a certain one plantation or tract of Land containing one hundred acres lying
