 for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and twenty dollars
 in hand paid to his stepson Enock Howell by James Lister of the
 District & State aforesaid have bargained sold and released
 and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said
 James Lister a certain tract or parcel of land containing one hundred
 Acres, be the same more or less it being a part of a tract of land orig-
 inally granted to Lemuel S. Stotok lying and being in the district
 and State aforesaid on the waters of Richland Creek, or water of Ruddy
 River having such markers bounds &c. as follows beginning on black
 Oak corner near the Spartanburgh Road thence across said Road
 along David Lesters line to a black oak corner thence along G. W.
 Carls line to a stake thence to a post oak corner on E. Greens line
 thence a long said line to a poplar corner on a branch thence up said
 Branch to a white oak at the head thereof thence on John Watson Senr's
 Line to a black oak on the above mentioned Road thence across
 said Road to the beginning corner together with all and singular the rights
 members hereditaments and appertinances to the said premises be-
 longing or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all
 and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said James
 Lister his heirs and assigns forever and I do here by bind myself my
 heirs Executors and admors to warrant and for ever defend the said
 premises unto the said James Lister his heirs and assigns against myself
 my heirs and against every other person who shall lawfully
 claim in the same or any part thereof by witness whereof I
 have hereunto set my hand and seal this 26th day of September 1820
