Whereas, by virtue of a writ issued from the court of Ordinary for the district and State aforesaid the nineteenth day of December in the Year of Our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and Twenty Five in order to make division between the heirs of John Tramm deceased, to me directed to advertise a certain Tract of Land in the district and State aforesaid containing one Hundred and twenty five acres, be the same more or less situate in Greenville district Originally Granted in part to Thomas Hamilton and Thomas Lewis lying on Horse Creek Waters of Reddy River; Beginning on a Short Gum 3+ on Horse Creek running thence N. 60. E. N. 50 to a red Oak 3+ bounded on William Tramm's Land thence N. 28 W. 28. 10 to a stake 3x bounded on land belonging to the heirs of John Tramm deceased thence S. 60. W. 2. 12 to a white Oak 3x thence N. 30 W. 47. to a holly 3x on said creek bounding on Thomas Hamilton, thence down the meanders of said creek to the beginning, and whereas the said premises with their appurtenances since the decree in the Court of Ordinary as aforesaid I have exposed to sale at public Vendue and purchased by Huolitt Sullivan of the district aforesaid for the sum of Two Hundred dollars being the highest sum that was bidder, Now know ye, that I Nimrod Underwood Sheriff aforesaid in pursuance of the said order in the Court of Ordinary, to me directed and delivered as aforesaid and by virtue of the Act of the General Assembly of this State in that case made and provided and for and in consideration of the said sum of Two Hundred dollars to me in hand paid or secured to be paid by the said Huolitt Sullivan the receipt and payment whereof I do hereby acknowledge, Have Granted bargained and sold and by these presents do Grant bargain and sell unto the said Huolitt Sullivan his heirs and assigns forever the said Tract piece and parcel of Land with its appurtenances and all the Estate right title and interest which the said John Tramm deceased of right had of us or to the same to have and to hold the said piece parcel and Tract of Land unto the said Huolitt Sullivan his heirs and assigns forever as fully and absolutely as I the said Nimrod Underwood might could or ought to Grant Bargain and sell the same by virtue of the act of the General assembly as aforesaid or otherwise.
