 Vickam of Greenville District in the State aforesaid, in consideration of Twenty Two
 Hundred and Fifty dollars, to me paid by Sandy Walker of Greenville District in the
 State aforesaid have granted, bargained sold and Released and by these Presents do
 Grant bargain sell and release unto the said Sandy Walker a certain house & Lot
 in the village of Greenville in the District and State aforesaid known in the plan
 of said Village as Lot No. 29 and part of Lot No. 27 as laid down by Vardry W. Bee and
 being part of those Lots sold and conveyed to me by said Vardry by deed dated the 13th
 February 1819 beginning at a Stake on Main Street and running thence N. 15. E. one
 Hundred and Fifty two feet to a stake to a stake at the corner of Main Street and
 North Street, thence S. 72. E. Two Hundred and Seventy four feet to a Stake, thence S 15
 W. One Hundred and Fifty two feet to a stake, thence N. 74 W. Two Hundred and twenty
 four feet to the beginning corner, Together with all and singular the Rights, ments,
 hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident
 or appertaining, to have and to hold all and singular the Premises before mentioned
 unto the said Sandy Walker his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind my
 self my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and
 singular the said premises unto the said Sandy Walker his heirs and assigns against
 myself and my heirs and against every other person or persons whomsoever Lawfully
 claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof. Witness my hand and seal
 this Twenty fifth day of July in the Year of our Lord One thousand Eight Hundred
 and Twenty Six and in the fifty first Year of the Independence of the United States of
