South Carolina Know all men by these Presents that I Archibald Taylor of Greenville District and State aforesaid in consideration of the Love and Good will which I have and bear to and for my son John Taylor as well as in consideration of one dollar to me in hand paid by the said John Taylor for the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained sold released conveyed and confirmed and by these presents do Grant bargain release convey and confirm unto the said John Taylor his heirs and assigns all that plantation or tract ^{of parcels} of Land containing one Hundred and Eighty six acres or the same more or less situate in Greenville District aforesaid in the fork between Musk creek and the meadow fork of said creek both waters of Tyger River and run, as follows, that is to say, Beginning on a stake on the meadow fork at a cross ditch, thence South thirty degrees East along the said ditch Nineteen chains and fifty links to a stake on Musk creek, thence up the meanders of said creek to a poplar, thence continuing up said creek to the mouth of a small branch, thence up said branch to a dead maple, thence North thirty nine and a half degrees West Twenty seven chains fifty links to a post oak, thence North twenty one degrees West fourteen chains to a post oak on the road, thence North sixty degrees East Six chains fifty links to a pine stump thence South sixty five degrees East Eight chains to a dead post oak, thence North Seventy Degrees East Seventeen chains to a pine stump in Hollup field, thence South thirty degrees East Fifteen chains to Pointers, thence North sixty degrees East Nineteen chains to a stake on the meadow fork of Musk creek, thence down the meanders of said creek to the beginning containing one Hundred and Eighty six more or less as aforesaid, Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the premises belonging or in any ways incident or appertaining, to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said John Taylor his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises above mentioned unto the said John Taylor his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs Executors and administrators and against all and every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
