 same or any part thereof, in whereof I hereunto set my hand and seal this first day
 of October One thousand Eight Hundred and Eleven. Signed Sealed and delivered in

 District and State aforesaid, for in consideration of Five Hundred dollars to me in
 hand paid by Absalom Blythe of Pendleton district and State aforesaid, have granted
 bargained sold and released and by these Presents do Grant bargain sell and release unto
 the said Absalom a certain Tract or Parcel of Land situate in the District aforesaid
 on the North side of the South Fork of Saluda and runs as follows, Beginning on a chert
 fire on the bank of the South Fork of Saluda River thence running S. 26. E. 21 chains
 50 links to a Black Sack Corner, thence So. 39. E. 29. 75 to a white Oak Corner, thence S.
 70. 16. 41 chains to the River, thence up the meanders of the River to the beginning chert
 fire corner, containing Four Hundred and Fifty two Acres be the same more or less *
 Together with all and singular, the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to
 the said Premises belonging or in anywise incident, to have and to hold all and singular
 the premises before mentioned unto the said Absalom Blythe his heirs and assigns forever.
 And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors Administrators to warrant and forever defend
 all and singular the said Premises unto the said Absalom his heirs and assigns against
 against myself my heirs and every other person whatsoever Lawfully claiming or to claim
