


South Carolina Personally appeared Garland Walker before me the subscriber and

District in the State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred and  
Eighty to me paid by Thomas J. Dean of the District and State aforesaid have granted  
bargained sold & released and by these presents do grant bargain sell & release unto  
the said Thomas J. Dean all that tract or parcel of land containing one hundred  
& twelve acres more or less situate in the State & district aforesaid on the south  
fork of Rocky Creek begining at a Black Gum 3x on sd. creek & runs N 18° E. 36.30  
to a Stake 3x on Charles Deans land thence N 24. 10. 47.5 to a Red oak 3x on thence  
on Lyn Walkers & John Smiths lines S 82. 10. 58. 00 to a small Hickory st. n. on said  
creek then down said creek to a black Gum 3x n thence S 48 E 4. 00 to a pop-  
lar 3x n thence S 99 E 1. 00 to a white Oak 3x n on said creek thence down said creek to  
the begining Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments & appurtenances  
to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold  
all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Thomas J. Dean his heirs and  
assigns forever and I do hereby bind my self my heirs Executors & administrators to warrant  
and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Thomas J. Dean his  
heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every person whomsoever  
lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand  
and seal the twenty first day of December A.D. 1825. Signed sealed & delivered in
