 Ford and Prussia Ford now Prussia Kirkpatrick and wife of the above named Lewis
 Kirkpatrick as heirs of the said Levi Ford and we the said John Ford and Lewis
 Kirkpatrick do hereby authorize and empower the said Bailey Butter to do and
 perform any act or acts thing or things whatsoever that shall be need full or
 necessary to be done touching or in any wise concerning the aforesaid Land or in the
 conveying or assigning them of to the purchaser in as full and ample a manner
 to all intents and purposes as we the said John Ford and Lewis Kirkpatrick might
 or could do if we were then and there personally present and also ratifying allowing
 and confirming all and whatsoever acts and things our said attorney shall do or
 cause to be done by virtue and according to the true intent and meaning of these
 presents and we hereby further authorize and empower our said attorney for us and
 in our names to ask for demand or sue for all debts due to the Estate of the
 said Levi Ford deceased and to execute receipts and acquittances for the same
 and to do all other acts and things necessary or need full to be done relative to the
 said Estate according to the true intent and meaning of these presents. In testimony
