


And confirm unto the said Francis Baswell his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land containing sixty eight acres more or less. Situate in the district aforesaid on the banks of Muske Creek waters of Tyger River being part of a tract of land conveyed by Archibald Taylor to myself and runs as follows, that is to say Beginning at a post oak on the ridge on the South East side of Muske Creek Lemuel Baswells corner thence South sixty eight and a half degrees west thirty one chains & fifty link to a red oak thence South nineteen degrees west twelve chains & fifty link to a white oak thence South eighty two degrees East twenty five chains to a stake three North thirty five degrees East from chain to a post oak stump thence due East five chains to a stake by a small branch then down the meander of branch to a maple at the mouth of said branch three North thirty five degrees West to the Beginning containing sixty eight acres more or less as aforesaid Together with all singular or the Rights, members hereditaments and appurtenances to the premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises above mentioned unto the said Francis Baswell his heirs and assigns for ever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the above mentioned premises unto the said Francis Baswell his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs Executors and administrators and against all and every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Know all men by these presents that Moses Findley of the State and district Greenville District for and in consideration of the sum of one thousand dollars to me in hand paid by Peter Hill of the State and district aforesaid have sold granted and released unto the said Peter Hill a tract or parcel of land situated between the No. and S. Saluda being estimated at four hundred acres less the same more or less Beginning upon a Hickory corner on the No River below the Old Yangard thence up the meanders of the River to Richard Youngs line thence along Youngs line to R. H. Foster thence along the said Fosters line down a branch to a white oak corner upon said branch thence a conditional line upon the dividing Ridge to a black oak & thence a conditional line binding upon Michael Whitmires land to a white oak thence binding upon Jeremiah Whitmires line to the beginning corner with all and singular the Rights members hereditaments and appurtenances houses plantations belonging to the said premises I bind myself my heirs Executors administrators and assigns unto the said Peter Hill his heirs Executors administrators and assigns to have and to hold free from me myself my heirs Executors administrators and assigns and do warrant and for ever defend the said premises free from me myself and all other persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof as Witness my hand and seal this 25 day of February in the year of Lord 1822 signed and sealed in the presence of us Samuel Rice, Robert Hill
