heirs and assigns all our respective Right title interest claim and demand of in or to a certain tract of
or parcel of land containing by estimation two hundred and fifty five acres by the same
more or less situate in Greenville District aforesaid on both sides of the South Fork of Tyger
River being the same Plantation wherein the said deceased last resided being the whole of
a tract of two hundred and five acres of land granted to John Collins the twenty first
day of January one thousand seven hundred and eighty five and runs as follows -
Beginning on a red oak on the north side of the said South fork of Tyger River due
north fifty two chains to a post oak thence so forty four degrees west fifty eight
chain so fifty links to a red oak thence south fifteen degrees East thirty six chains
to a red oak thence south sixty eight degrees East seventeen chains to a red oak
thence to the beginning Part of said tract is to be Excepted a small part sold to Robert
Goodlett off of the North corner also fifty acres of land joining the above taken off of a
tract of land granted to Thomas Lawry the twenty sixth day April 1786 making in the
whole two hundred and fifty five acres excepting the part sold Goodlett aforesaid
