

Benson her heirs and assigns forever and I do bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and for ever defend the right and title of the said negro woman and her increases from any person or persons claiming or to claim the same On testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this Eleventh day of August anno domini 1826 in presents

State of South Carolina Know all men by these presents that I Greenville District James Dickerson of the District and State aforesaid for and in consideration of three hundred and fifty dollars to me in hand paid by Thompson Dickerson of the State and district aforesaid hath granted sold and confirmed and released and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Thompson Dickerson all that plantation or tract of land containing two hundred and fifty acres be the same more or less situated in the said District on a branch of Rude fork waters of Rudy River bounded with the lines of a plat of the same annexed to a deed of conveyance from Henry Bishop to James Dickerson bearing as follows on the north E by lands of Benjamin Pallard Esqr. so by lands of James Seaton north by land we do not no. the owner of. East by lands of Edmund Sanders having such form, marker and shapes as is farley laid down in a plat annexed — Together the original grant together with all and singular the rights hereditaments to above described premises belonging or in any wise appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the said premises unto the said Thompson Dickerson and lawfull representative I will warrant and for ever defend the title to be good and do bind myself to defend the same from myself him and every other person lawfully claiming the same or any part or parcel thereof Given under my hand and seal this second day of October one thousand eight hundred and four — Test. William Dailey, Thomas Dickerson, James Dickerson 

State of South Carolina Personally came William Dailey and made oath Greenville District before me one of the Justices for the District aforesaid that he saw James Dickerson sign seal and deliver the within conveyance for the uses and purposes therein mentioned and that he and Thomas Dickerson in the presence of each other witnessed the same execution whereof sworn before me this 2nd day of March 1805
