 or tract of land wherein I now live situate lying and being in the dis-
 trict aforesaid and are of the branches of the Rudy fork waters of
 Rudy River Containing two hundred and fifty acres be the same more
 or less bounding as followeth on the north E. by land of Benjamin
 Pollard Esqr. So by land of James Seaborn north by lands we do not
 know the owner of E. by lands of Edmand Lanier having such forms
 Marks and Shapes as is fairly laid down in Plat annexed to the orig-
 inal grant together with all and singular the rights hereditaments
 to a bove described premises belonging or in any wise appertaining
 To have and to hold all and singular the said premises unto the
 the said James Dickerson and lawful representatives we will will
 -ant and for ever defend the title to be good and do bind our
 selves to defend the same from all men and every other person
 lawfully claiming the same or any part or parcel thereof given
 under our hands and seals this ninth of December Eighteen hundred
 and two and in the 21 of American independence Signed sealed
 and delivered In the presence of - Abner ^{his} Bishop
