aforesaid the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge and acquit the said William Doherty
Have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell
and release unto the said William Doherty his heirs Executors adm^rs and assigns forever
a certain tract of Land containing one hundred and fifty acres originally granted
to James West and signed by his Excellency Charles Pinckney on the second day of
February One thousand Seven hundred and eighty nine Situate and lying in
Greenville District on the opposite side from the waters of Enore River Beginning at a Rock & running
1040 chains to a post Oak 3x three 1.25 E. 49 chains to a hickory x3. thence N. 80 E. 18 chains
to a Stake x3. three due N. 55. chains to the begining corner Containing one hundred and
fifty acres as per Plat Together with all and singular the rights members tenan-
ties hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining
thereto the said William Doherty his heirs and assigns forever to have and to hold use
occupy possess and enjoy the same with every part and parcel thereof with all and singular
the privileges tenements hereditaments thereto belonging unto the said William Doherty his heirs
Executors adm^rs and assigns forever And I do hereby bind myself to warrant and forever defend
the Right and title from myself my heirs Exec^rs and from every person or persons whomsoever
lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
and seal this 20 day of December 1821. signed sealed and delivered in presence
