by these presents that I Master Rabers of the State and District aforesaid in  
consideration of the sum of Fifty dollars to me paid by Joseph McCullough  
of the State and district and by these presents do grant let bargain sell and  
release unto the said Joseph McCullough that plantation or tract of land  
containing fifty acres Be the same more or less situate in the state and  
district aforesaid lying on the south branch of Horse Creek waters of  
Rudy River begining on a Rock 3x running thence N. 20. 10 chains to  
a Stake 3x binding on land of Joseph McCullough now thence S. 80 E 32  
chains to a small hickory 3x bounding on Benj. Baister land thence S. 48 W  
33.40 to a Stake 3x binding on James Lawless land thence N. 43 W 10.40 to the  
beginning together with all the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances  
to the said premises in any wise incident and appertaining to have and to hold all  
and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Joseph McCullough his  
and his heirs and assigns for ever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and  
Administrators to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the said premises  
unto the said Joseph McCullough his heirs and assigns and against my self & my  
heirs & against any person or persons whatever lawfully claiming or to claim the  
same or any part thereof Witness my hand and seal the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of January in the  
year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty seven and  
in the fiftieth year of the independence of the United States of America  
signed sealed and delivered in the presence of
