paid by James Martin of the State & district aforesaid have granted her-
gained, sold & released & by these presents do grant, bargain sell & release unto
the said James Martin a parcel or tract of land lying in the State and District
aforesaid on the waters of Rudy River beginning on a red oak 3x. at the
Roade then running south 56. to a Stake binding on James Martins Land thence N. 36.
W. 25 to a Stake 3x. binding on Flimming Hatchers land, thence North 44.
to a red oak 3x. binding on William L. Gummell land, thence N. 39. E. 11. 50 to a red
oak 3x. at the road to the begining including the improvements where I
now live, with one hundred & thirteen & a half acres of land be the
same more or less together with all & singular the rights, members
heeditaments & appertinances to the said premises belonging or in any wise
incident or appertaining to have and to hold, all & singular the
premises before mentioned unto the said James Martin his heirs & assigns
for ever and I do hereby bind myself, my heirs Executors & Administrators
to warrant & for ever defend all & singular the said premises unto the
said James Martin his heirs & assigns against myself & my heirs & against
every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any
part thereof Witness my hand & seal this 15th November in the year of
our Lord one thousand eight hundred & twenty six & in the fifty fifth
year of the Independence of the United States of America

Grunville District Esq. - man of Greenville County and State aforesaid
for the natural love and affection that I have for my lawful son in law Daniel
Cockrum have made a free and voluntary gift of a field or tract of land
lying on the south side of Rudy fork waters of Rudy River it being part of a tract
of land originally granted unto James West by his Excellency William Moultrie Governor
and Commander in chief over said State on the sixth day of November one
Thousand seven hundred and Eighty six and by D. James West deeded unto
D. Hezekiah Cockrum confirmed and by these presents unto the said Daniel
Cockrum do release said land laid out as follows beginning on a Stake
on the original line in a marsh corner of a piece of land deeded to
John Gordon. running from thence down the marsh to where
it intersects a branch that runs from Isaac Roberts Spring thence
down sd. branch to the Creek thence down the waters of the Creek
until a certain white oak will be in line with the next corner
