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State of South Carolina. Know all men by these presents that I Henry E. Oldham  
of Greenville District in the State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of two  
hundred dollars to me in hand paid by Timothy H. Kuler of Newberry District in  
the State aforesaid have granted, bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant,  
bargain sell and release unto the said Timothy H. Kuler a plantation or tract of land  
lying and being situated in the State and district aforesaid on the East side of Enoree River  
commencing on the East bank of said River at a maple and fence thence along  
the line of J.H. Kuler land deeded to him by Jacob Wilson to a red oak thence south to  
to the west of chains 75 links to a stake thence 107 chains to a stake on the River  
thence up the various meanders of the River to the beginning enclosing one  
hundred acres be the same more or less together with all and singular the rights  
members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in  
any wise incident or appertaining excepting those acres deeded to Jacob Wilson  
to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Tim-  
othy H. Kuler and I do hereby bind myself and my heirs Executors and Administrators  
to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the premises before mentioned  
unto the said Timothy H. Kuler his heirs and assigns for ever against myself and  
my heirs and against every other person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim  
the same or any part thereof by virtue whereof I have hereunto set  
my hand and seal this 11<sup>th</sup> day of January 1827 and the fiftieth year of the American
