Danalson and her heirs for ever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and for ever defend the said negro girl unto the said Sarah R. Danalson and her heirs against myself and my heirs and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming the same In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this twenty third day of June in the year of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and twenty five and in the forty ninth year of the independence of the United States of America -
