



Dill & made oath that he saw Joseph Peace sign seal & deliver the within Conveyance unto Robert Pew for the purpose within mentioned & that Charley Wooten was a subscribing witness to the due Execution of the same December 9th 1826. Know all men by these presents that Sarah Clement of Charleston widow of John Clement and only heir at law of my deceased mother Ann Smith, in consideration of one hundred and fifty dollars to me paid by Lemuel Laffit of Greenville District in the State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Lemuel Laffit all that tract of land originally granted to the aforesaid Ann Smith by his Excellency Benjamin Lincoln by grant dated the 15 October 1784 for six hundred and forty acres situated on both sides of Thompsons Branch a creek near the head thereof and having such shape and marks as the plat annexed to the grant represents, and to be such corresponding form with the boundaries represented in the aforesaid survey to which all due reference is made together with all and singular the rights, members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Lemuel Laffit his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind my self my heirs Executors & administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Lemuel Laffit his heirs and assigns against my self and my heirs and against every person whosoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof Witness my hand and seal this — day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty six and in the Fiftieth year of the Independence of the United States of America sealed and delivered in the presence of
