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South Carolina ³ Doth know that Absalom Popham and James Smith Greenville District ³ Bargain in the following manner James Smith has settled with Samuel Moore forty seven dollars, with Adam Jones nine dollars 71 cents and has given his note to Absalom Popham for twelve dollars to buy corn for which the said Popham gives a mortgage of the following property. Know all men by these presents that Absalom Popham of the state and district aforesaid in consideration of the sum of twenty dollars and 23 cents to me in hand paid hath bargained sold and delivered and by these presents doth bargain sell and in plain and open market deliver unto James Smith of the state and district aforesaid the following property one blind mare with her in crease one cow & two yearlings ten head of hogs one bed and furniture one drupper and furniture one pot one oven and lid one Skillet two tables one chest one axe and one mattock two hoes one plane hook and Irons & one set of guns one loom one cotton wheel and card one water spade one smutting iron to have and to hold the above property unto the said James Smith his heirs Executors administrators and assigns for ever provided nevertheless and it is expressly agreed between the said

Parties that if the said Absalom Popham his heirs Executors or administrators shall want and truly pray or cause to be paid unto the above named James Smith his Executors administrators or assigns the full and just sum of forty seven dollars, twenty three cents as or before the twenty fifth day of December next then the above mortgage shall cease and be utterly void or else remain in full force and virtue in law.
