dollars to me paid by Jeremiah Cleveland and L. T. H. Brock of Greenville
District in the State of South Carolina have granted, bargained, sold and
released and by these presents do grant, bargain sell and release unto the said
Jeremiah Cleveland and L. T. H. Brock all and singular the four tracts of
land originally granted to Mr. D. Thomas the first by grant dated the 5th Decr. 1803
the second the 3rd day of April 1797, the third the 1st day of July 1793 and the
fourth dated 1st day of July containing containing Twenty two hundred and
ninety one Acres. be the same more or less, and including all the land
mentioned and represented in the said four grants and plats thereto
united which was willed by the said William D. Thomas to his son William D. Cul-
-bertson and now by his his lawful attorney conveyed to the said Jeremiah Cle-
-veland and L. T. H. Brock together with all and singular the Right, members,
hereditaments and appartenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise in-
-cident or appertaining to have and to hold, all and singular the premises
before mentioned, unto the said Jeremiah Cleveland and L. T. H. Brock their
heirs and assigns for ever, and I do hereby bind myself and my heirs, Executors and
Administrators to warrant and for ever defend, all and singular the said premises
unto the said Jeremiah Cleveland and L. T. H. Brock their heirs and assigns or
against myself and my heirs and against every other person or persons whomsoever
lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof. Witness my
