Thomas Vickers of the District of Greenville and State aforesaid have  
nominated constituted, and appointed and by these presents do nomi-  
nate constitute and appoint Benajah Dunham, my true and law-  
ful Attorney for me and in my name to collect - sue for and recover  
the amount of a promissory note of hand drawn in my favour, and  
signed by J. P. LaBruce lately deceased bearing date the first day of Novem-  
ber in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and twenty  
Six and made payable for the sum of one hundred and eighty four dol-  
lars and also to collect - sue for and receive the Interest that may be due  
and coming due due on the said Note and also to collect - sue for and receive  
the sum of three hundred and twenty three dollars twenty cents now due  
and owing to me by the Estate of the said J. P. LaBruce deceased and to collect  
- sue for recover and receive the whole of the aforesaid sums of money  
so due as aforesaid or either of the said amounts or any part of either  
or the whole, and for the same when received see discharges,  
and full and sufficient acquittances, receipts, and satisfactions  
to make, give and do. And I do hereby give unto my said attorney full  
power and authority to apply and pay over the aforesaid amounts when  
received or any part of the same, towards the payment and discharge of a  
certain note of hand, bearing date the third day of January in the year of  
our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and twenty six signed by me  
and the said Benajah Dunham as my security, and made payable to Lynn  
Walker for the sum of five hundred and fifteen Dollars by the said  
Benajah Dunham returning the over plus if any to me. And for  
the foregoing purposes I do hereby nominate and constitute the said  
Benajah Dunham my attorney irrevocable it being intended by me that  
this power of attorney shall operate as a full and complete transfer  
and assignment of all my right title Interest, Claim and demand what-  
soever which I might or could have in the aforesaid State and also in  
and to the aforesaid debt and demand due to me by the Estate of the  
said J. P. LaBruce for Carpenter's work done and performed and  
for materials found for and on the account and benefit of the  
said J. P. LaBruce in his life time and for his Estate the said note  
and the amount of the said account including all and every  
demand which I have in my shop or <sup>on</sup> any account whatever
