


Granted bargained sold & released & by these presents do grant bargain sell & release unto Gilman Smith of the same State & district a tract or parcel of Land lying in Greenville district on both sides of the Middle Tyger River Beginning at a Sweet gum tree on the East Bank of sd River and running thence N 40° W. 45 ch to a dead Pine thence S 60° W. 26. ch to a Black oak thence S 37° E. 10 ch to a Black Gum on the bank of the River thence S 85° E with the meanders of the River to a white oak sapling thence S 8 W. 4 ch 50 lfs with the River to a Maple & Birch thence S 67° W. to a branch & up the meander of the Branch 15 ch to a Chestnut near the mouth of Puffy Spring Branch thence up the branch 60.10 E including a spring 5 chs to a Stake near a Little oak on Thomas Spruce line thence N 50° E with his line to the beginning containing by Estimation one hundred and twenty eight & acres less the same more or less the same being the South & east end of a tract of land granted to Col. Thomas Taylor & from him to Joseph Smith Junr & from him to Perry Smith and his heirs such boundaries as above mentioned for the consideration of the sum of three hundred dollars to me in hand paid by Gilman Smith together with all and singular the above mentioned premises unto that contains thence unto the said Gilman Smith his heirs and assigns To have and to hold from & I do hereby bind my self my heirs & assigns to warrant & forever defend the said premises unto the said Gilman Smith his heirs and assigns & against the same myself my heirs & assigns & against all and every other person claiming the same or any part thereof this twenty ninth of November the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & twenty six & fifty first & fifty second of American
