Whereas Benjamin McRae and Zelia McRae his wife an on a Court the sixteenth day of June A.D 1823 did Exhibit their Bill of Complaint in the Court of Equity at Greenville Court-House in the said State against Susannah McCay widow of David McCay deceased, Ada May and Melome his wife, Egerton Spriggs and Louisa his wife, Robert Cox and Berisha his wife, Susan McCay the younger, Ira David McCay, Kitturier McCay, Chickrey McCay and Waddly Thompson McCay heirs and distinguisers of the said David McCay deceased, for partition of the Real Estate of the said David McCay among his heirs and distinguisers. And the Cause being at issue before the Honorable Court came on to be heard at June Term where the said Court after full hearing thereof, and mature deliberation in the premises did order, adjudge and decree that the said Real Estate whereof the said David McCay deceased did die seized and possessed should be sold at public auction by the Commissioner of the said Court on the Terms and for the purposes mentioned in their several orders as by Reference thereto in the Registry of the said Court will appear and the said William Choice as Commissioner of the said Court after having duly advertised the said several Tracts of Land for sale by public outcry on the fifth day of September A.D 1825 did then openly and publicly and according to the customs of Auctions, sell and dispose of the said tract of Land herein before described unto the said William Bates for Two hundred dollars being at that price the highest bid for the same Now therefore this Indenture witnesseth that the said
