Know all men by these presents that we Peter Boyle and Linney Boyle his wife of Jackson County and State aforesaid for & in consideration of the sum of Two hundred and ninety dollars to us paid by Wiley Kemp of Greenville District and State of South Carolina have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Wiley Kemp all that plantation or tract of land containing Eighty acre & one quarter acres more or less situate lying and being in Greenville District South Carolina on Brushy Creek granted to C. Farrow 15 October 1784. In three Hundred and twenty five acres being the one fourth and her part of her Father Richard Kemp's real Estate died. Also a nother piece or tract of land containing Ten acres more or less situated lying and being in Greenville district South Carolina being part of two Hundred acres belonging to Moses Kemp and belonging to Richard Kemp and being Linney Boyle's part in full of her father's real Estate died. Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Wiley Kemp his heirs and assigns for ever. And we do hereby bind ourselves our heirs & Executors from claiming the same or any part thereof — Witness our hands and seals this twenty first day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty seven and in the fifty second year of the Independence of the United States of America.
