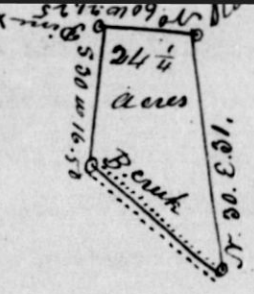
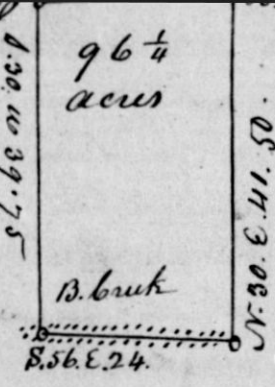

 Greenville District } Kemp and John W. Kemp of the state and district  
 aforesaid the heirs of the Estate of Richard Kemp deceased for an in consid-  
 -eration of the sum of five hundred dollars in hand paid to us by Wiley  
 Kemp of the state and district aforesaid do grant bargain sell and release  
 Ninety seven Acres of Land to Wiley Kemp it being a part of a tract of  
 Land originally granted to Gypman Gauer on the fifteenth of October one thousand  
 seven hundred and eighty four by his Excellency the Governor Benjamin  
 Guinard and surveyed by James Seaborn, now the Estate of Richard  
 Kemp decd and by us divided and hath such shape marker buttings  
 and boundaries as may be seen on the plat below we do Grant and relin-  
 -quish and for ever quit claim of the above mentioned parcel of land  
 unto the said Wiley Kemp his heirs assigns Executors or administrators free  
 from the claims of our selves our heirs assigns Executors and admin-  
 -istrators herein under our hands and seals this 13<sup>th</sup> December in the year  
 of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty seven
