

Know all men by these presents that I William Robbs Jr. of Greenville District and State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred dollars to me in hand paid by James B. Shields of the State & Dist. aforesaid the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have bargained grant sold & released & do by these presents bargain & grant sell & release unto the said Shields a tract of parcel land wherein the said Shields now lies situated in the district aforesaid on both sides of a small branch of South Tyger River Beginning on a pine 3x. n. 85 w. 4 chains E 0 3x thence N 89 w. R. 0.3x. N. 70. w. 28.50. to a Stake 3x thence N. 1. W. 37. to a R. 0.3x N. 70. E 38.50. to a red oak 3x thence south 32.50. to white oak 3x on the branch thence up the meander of the branch to a gum 3x thence S 20. E. 26. chains to the beginning which contains the land to be conveyed and contains by a late surveyer one hundred & fifty six Acres be the same more or less. Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, & appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining I do hereby bind myself my heirs, executors & administrators to warrant and forever defend the Rights and titles of the above described premises unto the said James B. Shields his heirs & assigns against myself my heirs Executors & admrs & against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 31st day of December in the year of our Lord A.D. One thousand eight hundred & twenty seven and in the fifty second year of American Independence.

Shields of the said State & Dist. have bargained, granted, sold & released and do by these presents bargain, grant, sell & release unto the said Shields a tract or parcel of land situated in said State & dist. on a branch of Frenchalb Creek waters of South Tyger River Beginning a Red oak corner on Joseph Barnard's line & runs with sd line 1. W. 2.75 chains to a pine corner at the head of a branch, thence down the sd branch S. 30. E. 24 chains to a maple corner down, thence S. 49. E. 8. Rods to a Stake corner thence a direct line to the beginning corner containing five acres be the same more or less Being part of a tract of one thousand acres originally granted to John Thomas Jr. together with all & singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances thereto belonging I do bind myself my heirs, executors & administrators to warrant & forever defend the aforesaid premises unto the said Shields, his heirs & assigns against myself my heirs, executors & administrators & against every other person or persons lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof Witness my
