Isaac Bradley a certain parcel or part of a tract of land whereon the sd. Bradley
now lives and was granted to Nicholas Daniel @ containingly computation
one hundred and fifty acres be the same more or less lying in the District of
Greenville. Beginning on a Gum at the main Road running through a pond
a conditional line between Richard Thurston and sd. Isaac Bradley to a
branch thence down & branch to Abraham Bradley line thence with sd.
A. Bradley line to Charles Benson line to a Red Oak corner thence with
sd. line to a red O. corner near Jerimah Strother Peach Orchard thence a
conditional line with sd. fence to sd. Isaac Bradley, old Peach Orchard
at the Road running round sd. Orchard thence running with sd. Road running
square a crop to the main Road to Charles Benson line thence with
said Road to the beginning corner with all & singular the Rights, numbers,
hereditaments & appurtenances then unto belonging or in any wise apper-
taining to have & to hold all and singular the premises unto the sd.
Isaac Bradley his heirs & assigns for ever I do hereby bind my self my
heirs Executors & Administrators to warrant and for ever defend all &
singular the Premises unto the sd. Bradley his heirs & against my self
my heirs & against every other person or persons whatsoever lawfully
claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof as witness my hand
and seal this 4th day of May 1816.
