Beginning on a pine 3x thence N. 34. E. 54. ch. to a stake 3x thence N. 44. W. 5. ch. Chestnut 3x thence S. 17. W. 96. 30 ch. Stone 3x and Legans land thence S. 54. E. 45. 50. Post Oak Ligno line S. 51. E. 23. to the Beginning Pine corner Containing by Estimation five hundred and seventy four acres be the same more or less which land was originally granted to James Sett by his Excellency William Moultrie, which land was Surveyed from Od Sett to George Harrison & from him to Thomas Edwards Senior and from him to William E. Wickliff and now from William E. Wickliff to J. H. Goodlett situate on the waters of the Saluda River, and the Long Branch of Reedy River together with all and singular the Rights, members, hereditaments and Appertances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the aforesaid described premises unto the said J. H. Goodlett his heirs and assigns for ever and I do hereby warrant and for ever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said J. H.
