

I have all men by these presents that we Thomas Langford and Delila Langford both of the district of Greenville and state aforesaid in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars to us paid by Dennis Braine of the state and district aforesaid, have granted Bargained sold and released unto the said Dennis Braine all that Tract or plantation of land lying in the district aforesaid on on the said west side of South Tiger River Beginning at a pine knot in the branch on David Bayley's line running thence N 25° E to the River to an ash corner on the bank of the River thence down the meanders of the River to a white oak corner on Absalom Nelson's line thence along said Nelson line to a stake corner thence along thence to a post or stump thence along David Bayley's line to the beginning corner containing One hundred and twenty eight acres be the same more or less together with all and singular the Rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said Dennis Braine his heirs and assigns for ever and we do hereby bind ourselves our heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Dennis Braine his heirs and assigns against ourselves and our heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
