South Carolina Greenville District I know all men by these presents that Samuel Hamley of Greenville District and state aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred and fifty dollars to me in hand paid by Lemitt Hamley of the state and district aforesaid have granted bargained and sold and Released by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Lemitt Hamley a plantation and tract of land lying and being situate in the district and state aforesaid on the branches of Gilders Creek waters of Enore River it being a part of a tract of land originally granted to James Warford beginning at Post Run No 70 N. 20. to a Post thence N. 60. to P. O. 3x. N. 72. E. 15 to P. O. 3x. S. 70. E. 39 to a chestnut and hickory 3x thence S. 35. to P. O. 3x. S. 50. N. 26. to a Stake 3x. S. 35. E. 10 to Road thence with the Road to the beginning including two hundred acres be the same more or less Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises, belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Lemitt Hamley and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors, and administrators to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Lemitt Hamley his heirs and assigns for ever against myself and my heirs and against every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 23rd day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty three and of the American Independence the forty seventh signed sealed and acknowledge in the presence of Stephen Hamley, John Sheppard Samuel Hamley (seal) (August 1824)
