 Greenville District Oath that he saw Nimrod Underwood sign and  
 deliver the within deed of Conveyance to John H. Goodlett for  
 the uses and purposes therein mentioned and that Richard  
 Thruston was a subscribing witness to the same with himself  
 Sworn to this 3<sup>rd</sup> day of March 1828 before  
 me Richd Thruston S.D. W. J. Howard  
 Recorded for the 3<sup>rd</sup> March 1828

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 The State of South Carolina Know all men by these presents that I John Brew  
 Greenville District of the State and district aforesaid in consideration  
 of the sum of five hundred dollars to me in hand paid by Samuel Moore  
 of the same place, have granted bargained and sold and by these pres-  
 ents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Samuel Moore a tract  
 of land containing two hundred and fifty acres lying and being in the  
 State and District aforesaid on the waters of horse Creek immediate-  
 ly on the Road leading from the Forks Meads to Lickville begining on  
 a black Oak 3x thence running N 5° 10' 50" E to a Stake 3x thence S 70° E  
 34 $\frac{1}{2}$  Chs. to a sweet-gum 3x thence N 40° E 36.50 Chs. to a Stake 3x thence  
 due North 4 Chs. to a Stake 3x thence due west 49 Chs. to the beginning  
 being in the year 1820. Conveyed to Robert Russell to said Brewer  
 for two hundred and fifty acres more or less. Now from said  
 Brewer to said Moore for the same to be resurveyed and if it  
 holds not two hundred and fifty acres the above price is given  
 if not to deduct in proportion for acre to the whole price given  
 Together with all and singular the rights members hereditam  
 and appurtenances to the same belonging or any noise incident or  
 appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the principles  
 before mentioned unto the said Samuel Moore his heirs Executors  
 administrators or assigns for ever. And I do hereby bind myself  
 my heirs Executors administrators or assigns firmly by these presents  
 to warrant and for ever defend the above tract of land unto the  
 said Samuel Moore his heirs or assigns and against myself my  
 heirs Executors administrators and every other person or persons who  
 soever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof Witness  
 my hand and seal this 19<sup>th</sup> September 1826. Signed sealed and
