

South Carolina. To all to whom these Presents shall come I am  
 as McDaniel Sheriff of Greenville district, and State aforesaid, send; Greeting  
 whereas, by virtue of a writ of fieri facias issued out of the Court of Common  
 Pleas held for the district of Greenville tested the fifteenth day of February  
 in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Twenty Eight  
 at the suit of S.B. Rutledge to me directed, commanding me, that of  
 the goods and chattels, lands, and tenements of John Hilleret to levy the  
 sum of Six Hundred and thirty five dollars twenty five cents damages  
 and costs. I have seized and taken <sup>all that certain piece parcel and tract of land containing</sup> of the lands and tenements of the said John  
 Hilleret One hundred and sixty three Acres more or less situate and being in the dis-  
 trict of Greenville and State aforesaid being a tract of land conveyed from Andrew  
 Nelson to John Hilleret on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of December 1825 and laid off to said  
 Hilleret as follows, lying on Both sides of Rudy Fork of Rudy River begining on  
 a white oak corner on William Cockrum's line thence along said Cockrum's  
 line to red oak corner, on Abraham Cockrum's line thence a long sd  
 Cockrum's line to a hickory corner thence on said line to Rudy Fork to a Spanish  
 Oak on Hance Black's line thence a long said Black's to a post-oak corner  
 on Wm. Pollard's line thence a long W. Pollard's line to a pine thence a long sd line  
 to a pine corner on George Scofts line thence a long said Scofts line to  
 a pine corner on Gilliland's line thence a long W. Gilliland's line to the be-  
 gining including one hundred and sixty three acres more or less. And whereas  
 the said premises, with their appurtenances, since the seizure by me made, by vir-  
 tue of the said writ of fieri facias before mentioned, have been exposed  
 to sale at public vendue, and purchased by Spencer B. Rutledge of the district of  
 Greenville and State aforesaid for the sum of fifty one dollars being the highest sum  
 that was bid on them for. Now Know Ye that James McDaniel Sheriff aforesaid  
 by virtue of the said writ of fieri facias aforesaid, to me directed and delivered as  
 aforesaid, and by virtue of the Statute in such case made and provided and  
 for and in consideration of the said sum of fifty one dollars to me in hand  
 paid or secured to be paid by the said Spencer B. Rutledge the receipt and  
 payment whereof I do hereby acknowledge, have granted bargained and sold  
 and by these presents do grant, bargain and sell unto the said Spencer B. Rutledge  
 his heirs and assigns for ever, the tract, place and parcel of land with its appur-  
 tenances, and all the Estate, right, title and interest which the said John  
 Hilleret of right had, of in or to the same to have and to hold the said place  
 parcel and tract of land with its appurtenances, unto the said Spencer B.  
 Rutledge his heirs and assigns for ever, as fully and absolutely as I the said  
 James McDaniel might, could, or ought to grant, bargain and sell the same by  
 virtue of the Statute aforesaid, and the said writ of fieri facias or other wise or  
 Witnes Whereof I the said James McDaniel have hereunto set my hand and seal the  
 Twenty third day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
