To all to whom these presents shall come I James McDaniel Sheriff of Greenville District and State aforesaid send greeting: Whereas by virtue of a writ of fieri facias issued out of the Court of Common Pleas held for the district of Greenville dated the twenty eighth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Twenty six at the suit of Cain Wells to me directed Commanding me, that of the goods and Chattels, lands and tenements of John Cockrum to levy the sum of four hundred and fifty dollars damages and Costs I have seized and taken of the lands and tenements of the said John Cockrum all that certain piece, parcel and tract of land containing Forty acres more or less situate and being in the district of Greenville and State aforesaid being a part of a tract of land originally granted to Elizafay on the 6th day of October 1788 and laid off to Elhanan Wells as follows. Beginning on a Stake 3^x thence to a Hickory on the original line 3^x thence to an ash 3^x on the branch thence down the meanders of the branch to the fork an Dials line thence to a post Oak 3^x thence along the original line to the beginning corner which land was conveyed from Elhanan Wells to John Cockrum which deed is recorded in the Clerks office of Greenville District in Book O page 285 and 286 bearing date the 8th of August 1803 and recorded the 28th July 1825 a Reference being had thereto will more fully appear And Whereas the said premises with their appurtenances since the seizure by me made by virtue of the said writ of fieri facias before mentioned have been exposed to sale at public Vendee and purchased by Jeremiah Cleveland of the District of Greenville and State aforesaid for the sum of forty five dollars being the highest sum that was bid therefor Now Know Ye that I James McDaniel Sheriff aforesaid by virtue of the said writ of fieri facias aforesaid to me directed and delivered as aforesaid and by virtue of the Statute in such case made and provided and for and in consideration of the said sum of forty five dollars to me in hand paid, or secured to be paid by the said Jeremiah Cleveland the receipt and payment whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain and sell unto the said Jeremiah Cleveland his heirs and assigns forever as
