 9.50 to a pine 3x the N. 68 E. 41 chains to the beginning. The other tract
 is the tract on which I formerly lived containing one hundred
 and twenty acres be the same more or less beginning on a
 Post oak on Edward Ballinger's corner from thence to the head
 of a branch on said Ballinger's line to a Stake corner from
 thence running a straight course across the little Shoal
 to a R.O. 3x on the South side of Enore River from thence

 warrant and defend the above premises unto the sd
 Henderson his heirs Exors admors & assigns against myself my
 heirs Exors & administrators and against every other person
 or persons lawfully claiming the same or any part
 thereof reserving the use of the said premises as long as
 I live or choose to have it In witness my hand & seal
 this 10th day January A.D. 1827 and in the fifty first year
 of a republican Independence.
