

I know all and by these presents that I Henry Benson of Lawrence County and State of Mississippi have nominated constituted and appointed and by these presents do nominate constable and appoint Henry James of Greenville District in the state of South Carolina my true and lawful attorney for me and in my name to do transact and perform all manner of business whatsoever touching and concerning me and to make sale of my Real Estate in the said State of South Carolina and to execute such deed or deeds of conveyance as may be required by the Statute of the State of South Carolina in my name and for me in as ample manner as I myself could do were I personally present and also do hereby empower and authorize the said Henry James to appoint and nominate such other agents and attorneys as he shall think fit and proper to assist in the sale of said Estate in South Carolina and hereby ratifying and confirming all such acts and doings as my said attorney shall and may perform touching the premises in pursuance of his said authority in as full and ample a manner as though I myself were personally present
