 ked by the crop Road, at the head of a hollow thence down the  
 Hollow and branch a straight course to a hickory 34 thence to the ford  
 of the branch thence with the old road an E. course as it meanders  
 it being the line to a hickory 34 thence a straight course to the begin-  
 -ing. Containing twenty five acres be the same more or less also  
 one other piece or tract of land adjoining the aforesaid  
 land on both sides of two small branches of Reddy River containing  
 one hundred and forty seven acres be the same more or less -  
 Beginning at a post oak thence N. 14 W. 9. ch 30 lks to a Red oak thence  
 N. 83 E. 14 ch 75 lks to Poplar on J. Hawkins land 78 E. 12. ch 40 lks to a  
 to a post oak on said Hawkins land thence S. 10 W. 49 ch to a Stake by
