or less situated lying and being in the state and district aforesaid
on the head waters of Bartons Fork of Tyger River Beginning on a
Chesnut thence north fifty East to a large Red Oak original
corner thence south sixty five East fifteen chains and fifty links
to a Locust thence south fifty five West to a Spanish oak in the
field near the branch, thence a straight line to the beginning Chesnut
corner it being part of a tract of land granted to Benjamin Bar
ton together with all and singular the rights, members hereditaments
and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise
incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular
the premises before mentioned unto the said Robert Pelman
his heirs and assigns for ever and I do hereby bind myself my
heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and for ever defend
all and singular the said premises unto the said Robert Pelm
an his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and against
every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming
or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand
