 Underwood Esquire Sheriff of Greenville District and State  
 aforesaid did by his own act and deed in writing trans-  
 fer and Release in fee simple certain Tracts of land therein  
 more particularly described and set forth, for the Express pur-  
 -pose of more effectually securing and save harmless  
 his Securities of office as Sheriff aforesaid, and giving and  
 granting to his Securities aforesaid, full power and author-  
 ity to sell and for ever carry the same bearing date  
 the 10 day of November 1827. which appears to have been  
 drawn by Waddy Thompson Esq. for the said Underwood's  
 Attorney at law and employed generally by him the said  
 Underwood Sheriff as aforesaid to settle all the said  
 Underwood's difficulties for which he was ruled to show  
 Cause &c. at the Court of Common Pleas Fall Term  
 1827. Know ye that we John Young, Thomas Benson,  
 Alexander Waddill, Thomas Wynne, Wheaton Merritt, John  
 Hodges, George Russell and Curtis Bradby the admin-  
 istrators of A. D. Bradby deed the Securities of the said Nimrod  
 Underwood Esquire Sheriff aforesaid, for and in consid-  
 eration of the sum of Four hundred dollars to us paid  
 by John Moore of the District and State aforesaid, have  
 granted bargained sold & released all that certain piece  
 parcel or tract of land originally granted to Gardner  
 and being a part of the original grant situate in the District  
 of Greenville and State aforesaid on the waters of Tellico River  
 and Rudy River that is to say Beginning on a Red oak 3x three  
 1/4 N. 1/4 S. to a post oak on Goodlitts and Mcbays line that he  
 had from Gardner to a beland post oak that divides Nicho-  
 las Fishers and Mcbays, from thence on the conditional line to
